SUBMISSION FORM

A separate entry form must be submitted with each entry to be considered for publication.
Students registered for at least one Bismarck State College class are eligible to submit for publication.

CALL FOR ENTRIES DUE Friday, March 5, 2021

Written Works:

Novella: One entry per student

Only one novella will be published per issue. Entries should contain 3000-8000 words.

Short Fiction and Nonfiction Essays: Two entries per student per category

Entries should not exceed 2500 words. (Roughly nine pages, double-spaced, 12-point font)

Poetry: Five poems per student

Instructions for all written work:

Submit either a paper copy or an electronic copy of each entry. If you leave a USB storage device with us, it may be picked up in Armory 143 after the magazine is published.

To submit paper copies:

- Type and double-space, using Microsoft Word. Do not put your name on the entry. Use a cover sheet that includes your name, phone number, e-mail address, and the title of the entry.

To submit electronic copies:

- USB flash drive: Talk to a Figments staff member or the adviser in Armory 143 or LEA Hall 303C.
- E-mail: Submissions must be sent from a BSC or NDUS email account. Send the submission as a Word document attachment to BSCFigments@ndus.edu.

Artwork: Three entries per student per category

Fine Art: Drawings, paintings, mixed media, or sculpture

Digital Art: Photo illustrations, graphic art, or commercial art

Photography: **Originals or digital file format (jpeg or tif) are required.** Artists may pick up their original copies in Armory 143 after the magazine is published.

Multimedia: Two entries per student per category (same submission guidelines as Artwork)

Video Documentary: Nonfiction. Submissions can be no longer than 60 minutes.

Creative Film: Short films, animation, video poetry performances or entries that don't fit into the above categories. Submissions can be no longer than 60 minutes.

Music Video: Submissions can be no longer 10 minutes.

Music: Two songs per artist/band. Submissions can be no longer than 10 minutes. (At least one person from a submitting band must be from Bismarck State College.)

To submit electronic copies of Artwork and Multimedia pieces:

- Submit a high-quality photograph of each entry. DO NOT submit the original work. A photographer is available if you are unable to take the photo yourself. Please contact a staff member or the Faculty Advisor at 224-5602. If you wish to submit a digital print, please send a high-resolution image (300dpi or higher) to BSCFigments@ndus.edu.
- USB flash drive: Contact a Figments staff member or the adviser in Armory 143 or LEA Hall 303C.
- E-mail: Send the digital copy as an attachment to BSCFigments@ndus.edu.
